Crisis/Emergency Services deliver around-the-clock emergency services, assessment, crisis intervention and acute services.

Addiction Services is an outpatient program designed to eliminate or reduce the suffering caused to individuals and families by addictions and to achieve a long-lasting recovery.

Rhode Island Consumer System of Care is a multidisciplinary program that provides a comprehensive range of psychiatric, rehabilitative, case management and supportive interventions to individuals with severe and persistent mental illness. The program helps individuals to live healthy, safe and independent lives in their own community environments.

Vocational and Psychosocial Rehabilitative Services provide supported employment and education, as well as community integration activities such as social network development and group activities for people living with mental health issues.

Outpatient Services provide individual, marital and group psychotherapy using various treatment approaches to meet the needs of each individual. Psychiatry services are also available.

Residential Programs for Adults offer housing and mental health services to adults with co-occurring and persistent mental health issues in long-term, transitional or semi-independent settings.
